

Private Hospitals and Health Services Act 1927 Notification of appointment – Director of Nursing

Appointment of Director of Nursing Form

Private hospitals, private day hospitals, private nursing homes and private nursing posts.

The Licensing Standards for the Arrangements for Management, Staffing and Equipment for each class of licence states that Standard 2, criteria 2.4 requires that a designated Director of Nursing (DoN) (however titled), or their suitably qualified replacement, be present at the facility at all times.

Annexure A (Additional Licence Terms and Conditions) – 1. A.5 Director of Nursing states, where there is a change of persons referred to in regulation 6 (a) of the Hospitals (Licensing and Conduct of Private Hospitals) Regulations 1987, the Department of Health is to be notified of the updated name and contact details within 7 working days.

If the DoN is absent, incapacitated or the position is vacant, the Licence Holder must appoint a person to act as the DoN during that period until such time a permanent DoN can be appointed to the position.

If you are notifying of a shared position, include the details of each person who will be working in the role.
